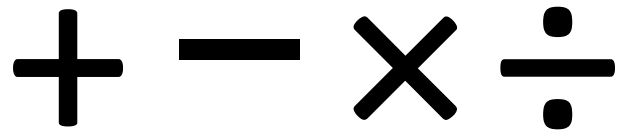


THIRD GRADE MATH
